

AT&T Campus MovieFest Grand Prize Sweepstakes Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Standard text messaging rates apply. If you enter via text messaging, you will incur charges for up to 4 messages per month. Message & data rates may apply. To stop receiving messages, text STOP or for help text HELP to 41234. Text-messaging entry is only available through AT&T Mobility.

1. Eligibility: AT&T Campus MovieFest Grand Prize Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least sixteen (16) years old (eighteen (18) years old if a resident of Maine) at the time of entry who have participated in a Campus MovieFest event and are a registered student in good standing at one (1) of the colleges or universities listed via the following link: <http://www.campusmoviefest.com/cgi-bin/WebObjects/AjayFlow.woa/wa/selectCampus> (select a region from the drop down bar to see if your university is participating). Employees of AT&T Mobility, Campus MovieFest, ePrize, LLC, and their parent and affiliate companies as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible. Subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and Sponsor's and Administrator's decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Each Entry Period will correspond with a specific geographic region. You must be a registered student in good status at a participating college or university located within that region (see Section 1, above, for more details) in order to enter during the region's respective Entry Period. Sponsor's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.

4. How to Enter: During the Promotion Period, there are two (2) ways you can enter the Sweepstakes:

Each Text Message received constitutes one (1) entry into the prize pool corresponding with the region where your college or university is located (see Section 6, below, for additional details). **Potential winners using a two-way text-messaging capable device may also be contacted by telephone regarding verification and prize claiming instructions; potential winners contacted by phone may incur charges according to standard rates, and potential winners agree to incur any and all such charges. Complete and submit the registration including a valid home address. P.O. Boxes are not permitted. You automatically will receive one (1) entry into the prize pool corresponding with the region where your college or university is located (see Section 6, below, for additional details).

For All Methods of Entry: Limit: Each participant may enter one (1) time per day during the Promotion Period. Multiple participants are not permitted to share the same email address or text messaging capable device. Any attempt by any participant to obtain more than the stated number of entries by using multiple/different email addresses, text-messaging capable devices, identities, registrations and logins, or any other methods will void that participant's plays/entries and that participant may be disqualified. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible or misdirected registrations, which will be disqualified. Otherwise, the "authorized account holder" of a text-messaging capable device is the natural person in whose name the device has been issued and the services are billed. Potential winners may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.

5. Winner must commence travel and conclude travel on Sponsor selected dates, or the travel component of the prize will be forfeited.

ONE (1) SOUTHERN REGION GRAND PRIZE: A prize package including a movie equipment package, consisting of an Apple MacBook Pro, Apple Final Cut Studio software, Apple Logic Studio software, an Apple iPod touch 8GB and a Panasonic HDC-HS100 HD Camcorder; a Samsung handset; \$4,000 that winner can apply to cover a portion of the taxes and/or fees associated with prize receipt and/or use; a \$400 AT&T gift card (terms and conditions apply); and trip for two (2) to the Tribeca Film Festival including roundtrip, coach-class air transportation for two (2) from a major airport near winner's home (determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion) to New York, New York, three (3) nights accommodations at a hotel of Sponsor's choice (single room, double occupancy), a meet and greet with a movie director or producer of Sponsor's choice; and two (2) 1-day passes to the Tribeca Film Festival. No refund or compensation will be made in the event of the cancellation or delay of any flight. Travel and accommodations are subject to availability. Travel is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Sweepstakes, and those set forth by the Sponsor's airline carrier of choice as detailed in the passenger ticket contract. Winner will not receive difference between actual and approximate retail value. Each prize and its respective components are non-transferable and no substitution will be made except as provided herein at the Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason. Each winner is responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use. Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received during the prize's respective Entry Period. Limit: One (1) prize per person. Total ARV of all prizes: \$42,375.

7. Disputes: Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Sweepstakes or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan (Southern Division) or the appropriate Michigan State Court located in Oakland County, Michigan; (2) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Sweepstakes, but in no event attorneys' fees; and (3) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the entrant and Sponsor in connection with the Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with,

the laws of the State of Michigan without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of Michigan or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Michigan.
